Saint Peter Library 2021

- 4,402 new items were added to our catalog in 2021
- **100,649** items were checked out from our library. This number is close to our pre-pandemic yearly number of checkouts.
- 2,984 active library card holders and we issued 796 new library cards in 2021.

6,997 items were requested to borrow from TDS libraries by St.Peter patrons through Encore (patron online card catalog)


- St. Peter loaned out 619 items to MNLink libraries.
- St.Peter borrowed 716 items from member MNLink Libraries.

The TDS region checked out **1,088,212** items in 2021. (908,000 in 2020)

Digital Library

6,341 eBooks and eAudiobooks were borrowed through Overdrive (3,542 ebooks, 2,799 Audiobooks) **526** Mobile patrons (patrons have library cards for the sole access of Overdrive)

7,936 eBooks, eAudiobooks, music, movies and comic books borrowed through Hoopla (graph below)

6,645 Chromebox sessions were used on 7 patron computers

25,324 wifi sessions used (a session is considered anytime a device connects to the library wifi)
