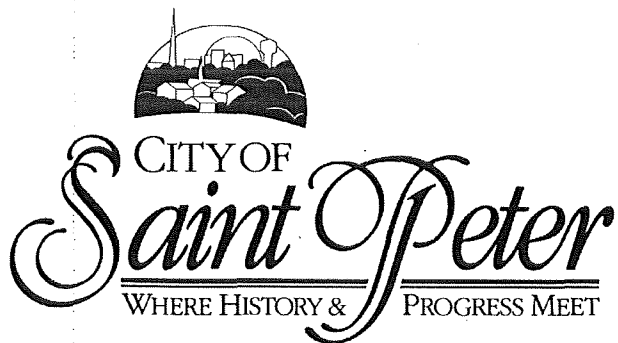
OTHER REPORTS: Chief Grochow detailed the current application and interview schedule to fill one open position.
